**T**HE Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above bounden *Anna*  
*Peck* Administratrix of  
 all, and singular the Goods, Chattles, Credits and Estate of *Levin Peck* late  
 deceased, do make or cause to be  
 made, a true and perfect Inventory, of all and singular the Goods, Chattles, Credits,  
 and Estate of the said deceased which have or shall come to the Hands, Possession, or  
 Knowledge of the said *Anna*  
 or into the Hands, or Possession of any other Person or Persons, for her and  
 the same to make, do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the said Court  
 of Probate, in the District of *Saltfield* at or before the *18<sup>th</sup>* Day of *August*  
 next coming. And the same Goods, Chattles, Credits and Estate, and all other  
 the Goods, Chattles, Credit and Estate of the said deceased, at the time of her death,  
 which at any Time after shall come to the Hands or Possession of the said *Anna*  
 or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for her to  
 do well and truly administer according to Law. And further, do make or cause to be
