Then we set off to Anna Humaston (?) one chair amounting to fifty-five cents & four milles, it being her full propostion (?) \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Wealthy the 2<sup>nd</sup> daughter of the deceased one chair amounting to the sum of fifty-five cents & four milles. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Polly the 3<sup>rd</sup> daughter of the deceased one chair amounting to the sum of fifty-five cents & four milles. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Linus Peck 4<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased one chair amounting to the sum of fifty-five cents & four milles. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Simon (?) 5<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased one chair amounting to the sum of Fifty-five cents & four milles. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Rachael 6<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased half bufhel 0.50 - one spoon 5 4/01 \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Hannah 7<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased three pewter \_\_\_\_\_ 37 cents, two glafs bottles 12 cents, one earthen pot. 6 cents 4/10 \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to N\_\_\_\_g 8<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased one flat iron 34 cents, psalm book 17 cents, one spoon 4.4/10. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Nancy 9<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased \_\_\_\_\_ earthen plails (?) 51 cents one spoon 4 4/10. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Levi 10<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased one bible 34 cents, one sickle 17 cents One spoon 4 4/10. \$0:55 4/10

Then we set off to Julia 11<sup>th</sup> heir of the deceased one saddle 50 cents - one spoon 5 4/10 \$0:55 4/10

The whole of the estate to be distributed according to the order of the Court given and Amounted to \$9. 15/100 which we have \_\_\_\_\_ as above specified -- Done at Litchfield the first day of April A.D. 1803.

one Chair amounting to the sum of fifty <sup>five</sup> cents & four mills \$0: 55: 4

Then we set off to Anna Peck 3<sup>rd</sup> Sister of the Deceased one  
Chair amounting to fifty five cents & four mills \$0: 55: 4

Then we set off to Lucretia 5<sup>th</sup> Sister of the Deceased one  
Chair amounting to fifty five cents & four mills \$0: 55: 4

Then we set off to Sarah 6<sup>th</sup> Sister of the Deceased  
half Bushel, 50 - one Spoon - - - \$0: 55: 4

Then we set off to Hannah 7<sup>th</sup> Sister of the Deceased  
three pocket knives, 37 cent, two glass bottles 12 cents one  
Earthen pot. 6 cents to - - - - - \$0: 55: 4

Then we set off to Nancy 8<sup>th</sup> Heir of the Deceased  
one Flat Iron 31 cents. feather book 17 cents one Spoon  $5\frac{1}{10}$   $\$0.55\frac{1}{10}$

Then we set off to Nancy 9<sup>th</sup> Heir of the Deceased  
seven Earthen plates 51 cents one Spoon  $5\frac{1}{10}$   $\$0.55\frac{1}{10}$

Then we set off to Levi 10<sup>th</sup> Heir of the Deceased  
one Bible 34 cents one Saddle 17 cents one Spoon  $5\frac{1}{10}$   $\$0.55\frac{1}{10}$

Then we set off to Julia 11<sup>th</sup> Heir of the Deceased  
one Saddle 50 cents one Spoon  $5\frac{1}{10}$   $\$0.55\frac{1}{10}$

The whole of the Estate to be distributed  
according to the order of Court given  
at commencement to  $\$9.15\frac{10}{100}$  which we  
have divided as above specified - Done at  
Litchfield this first day of April A.D. 1803
