

TIPPECANOE CEMETERY

Located on each side of SR-331 approximately one mile north of the town of Tippecanoe, north of the Tippecanoe River, in Old Tiptown, Tippecanoe Township, Marshall County, Indiana.

The cemetery is divided into 5 sections; the rows run north and south in all five sections. Section 1, located on the west side of the road, the rows are numbered from east to west; stones read from south to north.

Sections 2 through 5, located on the east side of the road, the rows are numbered from west to east; stones read from north to south.
